2010/2011 REGULATIONS.

ELIGIBILITY

- Children eligible to compete must be at least 9 years of age at 31/8/2010. Children who are 9 years of age on the date of the competition may also compete.
- Competitors must wear their athletic club's colours together with suitable footwear.

FEES

- The affiliation fee per Club will be £20. Athletes will pay £2 per competition (To be collected by Team managers). The DAA Treasurer will invoice participating clubs for total amounts at the end of the sportshall season.

SCORING

Individual Events

1st 8pts 2nd 7pts 3rd 6pts 4th 5pts 5th 4pts 6th 3pts 7th 2pts 8th 1pts if there are 4 competing clubs (or 10pts, 9, 8 etc if there are 5 competing clubs)

Relay and Parlaaf

1st 4pts (or 5 pts if there are 5 competing clubs) 2nd 3pts 3rd 2pts 4th 1pt

- Two athletes from each club to score in individual events with one team to score per Relay and Parlaaf. All age group match points will be accumulated to give the overall winner per match. This will be then converted to league points. Clubs will be awarded league points 1st.....4pts (or 5pts if there are 5 competing clubs), 2nd...3pts etc per match per age group.

EVENTS

Sportshall Competitions

- The Sportshall Competitions for 2010/11 will take place at the Queens Park Leisure Centre, Chesterfield on the following dates, all start at 1.30pm.

Regional and National Finals.

- The teams representing Derbyshire will be selected by the Mini League selection panel. Selection will be based only on Sportshall performances throughout the season of the Final with the exception of the HJ. Athletes must have competed in at least 2 matches that season to be eligible for selection. All athletes must have a county qualification.
- The Regional Finals for U13 and U15 competitions will take place on Sunday 20th February 2011 at Grantham, Lincolnshire. The Fun In Athletics U11s Final is on 30th January.
- The U13 and U15's National Finals will be held on a date to be announced.

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

The Sportshall Competitions and Finals will comprise a selection of the following events:

Individual track events

1 lap U11

2 lap U11, U13, U15

3 lap U11

4 lap U13, U15

6 lap U13

Individual field events

Vertical High Jump U11, U13, U15G

Standing Long Jump U11, U13, U15

Sitting Throw U11

Shot U13, U15

Standing Triple Jump U11, U13, U15B

Speed Bounce U11, U13, U15

Relay Events Parlaaf events

4 x 2 lap relay U13, U15

8 lap parlaaf U13, U15

4 x 1 lap relay U11

In addition there will be 1 lap guest races for U9's

Format of Sportshall Competition

- Two athletes from each athletic club will be eligible to score in each individual event and one team from each athletic club will be eligible to score in each relay event.
- Track events will be run in one or more races dependent on the number of competitors. Positions will be established based on times.
- Each athlete can compete in a maximum of four events, one of which must be a relay (Parlaaf will be classed as an individual event in this respect). This rule applies to all age groups. All competitors must wear a club vest and number. Any competitor competing in more than the allowed number of events will automatically be classed as a non-scorer.
- Clubs are to allocate a permanent number to each athlete which is to be retained throughout the season. Numbering for all clubs is the same as in the T&F Mini League (AVAC 1 – 99, DAC 100 – 199, CDAC 200 – 299, BADYS / Buxton 300 – 399, 2DASH 600 – 699).
- All competitors will be allowed three trials in field events. In the speed bounce each competitor is allowed one trial, 20 seconds for the Under 11's and 30 seconds for the Under 13's and Under 15's.
- It is the team manager's responsibility to ensure that all competitors who are called away from field events to track races return immediately for their outstanding trials.

AWARDS

The following awards will be presented;

End of season awards

(1) A trophy for the best boys and girls team in each age category.

(2) A trophy for the best overall team of the season.

(3) A trophy for the outstanding girl and boy athlete per match of the season. (to be kept)

Trophies (1) & (2) will be retained until the final event of the following season.

It is the Team Managers responsibility to return trophies when required.

OFFICIALS

- Participating clubs are expected to provide Team Managers, a Timekeeper, Track Judge and a Field team at each event. PROTESTS

- In all matters the decision of the referee is final. Protests and disqualification are not in the spirit of Sportshall Athletics.

Information for all Team Managers

- County selection will be based on all-round ability. Please ensure your athletes cover most events during the course of the League competition. Being the best athlete in one event will not guarantee selection.
- Team managers must email team declarations to the match results team prior to the start of the first match. This is essential for an efficient and quick results service. Additional athletes throughout the course of the season must be allocated an unused number from each club's allocated range and the results team notified accordingly.
- Team managers are responsible for making sure that their members report to their event when called, please ensure that your athletes are well behaved and set a good example. **Please leave the sportshall tidy**
- Event programmes should be provided to parents by their own club.
